Criteria for Assistance

Our by-laws allow funds to be distributed to persons or organizations that meet either of the following criteria:

- Charitable organizations based in the State of New Jersey that need financial and/or technical assistance with Information Technology to support their mission
- Individuals residing in and studying in New Jersey who need financial assistance to continue their education, particularly in disciplines related to Information Technology

Sources of Funds

The Foundation's main fundraising event is its very popular Foundation Golf Outing. One hundred percent of the profits from this event go to the NJ SIM Foundation. Additionally, the Chapter participates and sponsors conferences and other special events for Information Technology executives and at the discretion of the SIM NJ Executive Committee, shares the profits from such events with the Foundation.

Other funding is provided by additional fundraising events, corporations (contributions and gift-giving), individuals/members (including opportunities for matching company funds) and special programs.

Programs and Events

Annual Foundation Charity Golf Outing: the Foundation's major fundraising event.

NJ SIM Foundation honored Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northern New Jersey as the beneficiary of our 2019 event. Funds donated will help fund BBBSNJ's Big Computer Lab and STEM initiative, a key element of their strategic 50 Years and Beyond Campaign.

Grant Recipients: Twice a year, the Foundation awards grants to a select group of not-for-profits for technology projects. Since the inception of the Foundation, over \$800,000 has been distributed.

IT Scholarships: Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate high scholastic performance, leadership, community service and financial need. Recipients attend a 4-year college/university in pursuit of a bachelor's degree in an Information Technology discipline.

IT Career Awareness with Middle Schools, An interactive program introducing technology & STEM careers to middle school students now in its fifth year of delivery.
